TO PROHIBIT THE CLOSURE OF THE EASTERN CAROLINA STATE VETERANS

CEMETERY IN GOLDSBORO.";

And on page 4, lines 9-11, by rewriting those lines to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) shall not close any of the State-owned veterans cemeteries. DMVA shall continue to operate all the State-owned veterans cemeteries and shall maintain the current level of operations at each of those cemeteries. The Office of State Budget and Management shall realign the base budget for the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs for the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium to increase receipts and include operational costs of the Eastern Carolina State Veterans Cemetery in Goldsboro.

SECTION 6. Section 5 of this act is effective when this act becomes law. Section 4 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2017. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law. Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply beginning with the 2017 fall academic semester."
