1	moves to amend the bill on page 6, by inserting the following between lines 45 and 46:
2	"SECTION 5.5(a). G.S. 14-54 reads as rewritten:
3	"§ 14-54. Breaking or entering buildings generally.
4	(a) Any person who breaks or enters any building with intent to commit any felony or
5	larceny therein shall be punished as a Class-H felon H felon; however, if any person is in actual
6	occupation of any part of the building at the time of the commission of the crime, the person
7	committing the crime shall be punished as a Class F felon.

Any person who breaks or enters any building with intent to terrorize or injure an 8 (a1) 9 occupant of the building is guilty of a Class H Class F felony.

Any person who wrongfully breaks or enters any building is guilty of a Class 1 10 (b) 11 misdemeanor.

12 As used in this section, "building" shall be construed to include any dwelling, (c) 13 dwelling house, uninhabited house, building under construction, building within the curtilage of a dwelling house, and any other structure designed to house or secure within it any activity or 14 15 property."

SECTION 5.5(b). This section becomes effective December 1, 2017, and applies 16 to offenses committed on or after that date.". 17
