The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Article 4 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a		
new section to read:		
"§ 135-75.1B. Forfeiture of retirement benefits for impeachment or removal from office.		
<u>(a)</u> <u>T</u>	he Board of Trustees shall not pay any retirement benefits or allowance	s, except for a
return of member contributions plus interest, to any judge who is impeached for reasons other than		
a physical or mental incapacity interfering with the performance of the judge's duties.		
(b) The Board of Trustees shall not pay any retirement benefits or allowances, except for a		
return of m	nember contributions plus interest, to any judge removed from	office under
<u>G.S. 7A-376(b).</u> "		

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
