SECTION 3.(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season
for taking coyotes and foxes with weapons and by trapping during the trapping season set by the
Wildlife Resources Commission each year, with no tagging requirements prior to or after sale.
<b>SECTION 3.(b)</b> No bag limit applies to foxes or coyotes taken under this act.
<b>SECTION 3.(c)</b> This section applies only to Davie County and to those portions of
Forsyth County outside the city limits of the City of Winston-Salem.
<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2018.
