- 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO DETERMINE THE ELIGIBILITY OF STATE-RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBES 3 TO RECEIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS 4 FROM NONPROFITS AND CHARITABLE FOUNDATIONS. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the legal status of 7 the State-recognized Indian Tribes named in Chapter 71A of the General Statutes. The purpose 8 of the study is to determine whether any statutory changes are necessary to enable the tribes to be eligible to apply for and receive economic development and disaster recovery grant funds 9 from nonprofits and charitable foundations. The Commission shall report its findings and 10 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 2019 General Assembly. 11
