moves to amend the bill on page 16, lines 13-14, by inserting the following between the lines:

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## **"PART IV. OTHER ELECTION LAW CHANGES**

**SECTION 4.1(a)** G.S. 163A-1300(b), as amended by S.L. 2018-112, reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Not earlier than the third Wednesday before an election, in which absentee ballots are 7 authorized, in which a voter seeks to vote and not later than 7:00 P.M. on the last Friday1:00 8 P.M. on the last Saturday before that election, the voter shall appear in person only at the office 9 of the county board of elections, except as provided in G.S. 163A-1303. A county board of 10 elections shall conduct one-stop voting on the last Saturday before the election from 8:00 A.M. 11 until 1:00 P.M. and may conduct one-stop early voting until 5:00 P.M. on that Saturday. That voter shall enter the voting enclosure at the board office through the appropriate entrance and 12 shall at once state his or her name and place of residence to an authorized member or employee 13 14 of the board and present photo identification in accordance with G.S. 163A-1145. In a primary election, the voter shall also state the political party with which the voter affiliates and in whose 15 primary the voter desires to vote, or if the voter is an unaffiliated voter permitted to vote in the 16 17 primary of a particular party under G.S. 163A-989, the voter shall state the name of the authorizing political party in whose primary he wishes to vote. The board member or employee 18 19 to whom the voter gives this information shall announce the name and residence of the voter in 20 a distinct tone of voice. After examining the registration records, an employee of the board shall state whether the person seeking to vote is duly registered. If the voter is found to be registered 21 22 that voter may request that the authorized member or employee of the board furnish the voter 23 with an application form as specified in G.S. 163A-1391. The voter shall complete the application in the presence of the authorized member or employee of the board, and shall deliver 24 the application to that person." 25

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31 32 "(4) If the county board of elections opens one-stop sites on Saturdays <u>other than</u> <u>the last Saturday before the election</u> during the period required by G.S. 163A-1300(b), then all one-stop sites shall be open for the same number of hours uniformly throughout the county on those Saturdays."";
