1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, lines 3-7, by rewriting those lines to read:

2 ""SECTION 15.9.(f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or a provision of  
3 the Committee Report described in Section 39.2 of this act to the contrary, the grant-in-aid in the  
4 amount of seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) provided to the Town of Cedar Point for  
5 downtown revitalization in Section 15.8(a) of this act shall instead be provided as follows for the  
6 purpose of downtown revitalization:

- 7 (1) Ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to the Town of Trenton.
- 8 (2) Ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to the Town of Pollocksville.
- 9 (3) Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to the Town of Maysville.
- 10 (4) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to the Town of Princeton.
- 11 (5) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the Town of Mount Olive.
- 12 (6) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to the City of Goldsboro.
- 13 (7) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the City of Kinston.
- 14 (8) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the City of New Bern.
- 15 (9) Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to the Town of Pink Hill.
- 16 (10) Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to the Town of Lillington.
- 17 (11) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the Town of Tabor City.
- 18 (12) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the Town of Cedar Point.""
