1 call of the cochairs. A quorum of the Committee shall be 10 members. The Committee may meet 2 in the Legislative Building or the Legislative Office Building. With approval of the Legislative 3 Services Commission, the Legislative Services Officer shall assign professional staff to assist the 4 Committee in its work. The House of Representatives' and the Senate's Directors of Legislative 5 Assistants shall assign clerical staff to the Committee, and the expenses relating to the clerical 6 employees shall be borne by the Committee. 7 SECTION 6. Report; Termination. - The Committee may make an interim report of its findings and recommendations to the 2018 Regular Session of the 2017 General Assembly and 8 9 shall make a final report of its findings and recommendations to the 2019 General Assembly prior 10 to its convening. The Committee shall terminate on the convening of the 2019 General Assembly,

- 11 or upon the filing of its final report, whichever occurs first.
- 12 **SECTION 7.** Effective Date. This act is effective when it becomes law.
