- 3 4 COMMENCE AN ACTION. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 1-17 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (a), (b), and (c) of this section, a 7 "(d) 8 plaintiff may file a civil action against a defendant for sexual abuse suffered while the plaintiff 9 was under 18 years of age until the plaintiff attains 45 years of age."
- **SECTION 2.** G.S. 1-52 reads as rewritten: 10
- 11 "§ 1-52. Three years.
- 12 Within three years an action -. . .
  - For criminal conversation, or for any other injury to the person or rights of (5) another, not arising on contract and not hereafter enumerated, enumerated, except as provided by G.S. 1-17(d).
- 18 Unless otherwise provided by law, for personal injury or physical damage to (16)claimant's property, the cause of action, except in causes of actions referred to 19 20 in G.S. 1-15(c), shall not accrue until bodily harm to the claimant or physical 21 damage to his property becomes apparent or ought reasonably to have become apparent to the claimant, whichever event first occurs. Except as provided in 22 23 G.S. 130A-26.3, G.S. 130A-26.3 or G.S. 1-17(d), no cause of action shall accrue more than 10 years from the last act or omission of the defendant giving 24 25 rise to the cause of action.
  - For assault, battery, or false imprisonment.imprisonment, except as provided (19)by G.S. 1-17(d). ...."

SECTION 3. G.S. 1-56 reads as rewritten:

31 "§ 1-56. All other actions, 10 years.

. . .

32 An-Except as provided by subsection (b) of this section, an action for relief not (a) otherwise limited by this subchapter may not be commenced more than 10 years after the cause 33 34 of action has accrued.

35 A civil action for child sexual abuse is not subject to the limitation in this section." (b)



## General Assembly Of North CarolinaSession 2019SECTION 4. Effective from January 1, 2020, until December 31, 2020, this act

1 **SECTION 4.** Effective from January 1, 2020, until December 31, 2020, this act 2 revives any civil action for child sexual abuse otherwise time-barred under G.S. 1-52 as it existed 3 immediately before the enactment of this act.

4 **SECTION 5.** Except as specifically provided by Section 4 of this act, this act is 5 effective when it becomes law and applies to civil actions commenced on or after that date.
