5	SECTION 5. G.S. 160A-300.1(c), as amended by Section 1 of S.L. 2007-341, is		
6	amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
7	"(4a) A municipality enacting an ordinance implementing a traffic control		
8	photographic system may enter into a contract with a contractor for the lease,		
9	lease-purchase, or purchase of the system. The municipality may enter into		
10	only one contract for the lease, lease-purchase, or purchase of the system, and		
11	the duration of the contract may be for no more than 60 months. After the		
12	period specified in the contract has expired, the system shall either be the		
13	property of the municipality or removed and returned to the contractor."		
14	SECTION 6. The Cumberland County Board of Education may enter into, with a		
15	town listed in this section, an interlocal agreement necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose		
16	and intent of G.S. 160A-300.1 and this act. Any agreement entered into pursuant to this section		
17	may include provisions on cost-sharing and reimbursement that the Cumberland County Board		
18	of Education and the town freely and voluntarily agree to for the purpose of effectuating the		
19	provisions of G.S. 160A-300.1 and this act. The towns authorized in this section are Hope Mills		
20	and Spring Lake.		
21	SECTION 7. Section 4 of this act applies to the City of Fayetteville and to the Towns		
22	of Hope Mills and Spring Lake. The remainder of this act applies only to the Towns of Hope		
23	Mills and Spring Lake and the Cumberland County Board of Education.		
24	SECTION 8. Section 3 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2019, and applies to		
25 26	violations committed on or after that date. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
