The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 21C of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by	
adding a new section to read:	
"§ 143-215.116A. Wind energy facilities prohibited in certain areas.	
<u>Constru</u>	ction, operation, or expansion activities associated with a wind energy facility shall
be prohibited in any location included in the area designated in red as "Significant" on the map	
entitled "Vertical Obstruction Impact on the NC Military Mission," as the impacts of vertical	
obstructions in this area have been determined to be significantly high, with a high risk for	
degrading safety and the military's ability to perform aviation training. The Department of
