The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Article 21 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by		
adding a new section to read:		
"§ 115C-316.2. Appropriation for school counselors and psychologists.		
(a) Beginning with the 2019-2020 fiscal year, there is appropriated from the General		
Fund to the Department of Public Instruction for the following fiscal years the following amounts to the instructional support allotment:

	Then developing the base budget, as defined by G.S. 143C-

(c) Funds appropriated pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall be allocated to local		
school administrative units to increase positions for school counselors and school psychologists		
in the following fiscal years to the following statewide ratios of personnel to students:

(d) School counselors hired from funds provided pursuant to subsection (a) of this section		
shall have, as a first responsibility, preventative and responsive services, as provided in		
G.S. 115C-316.1(a)(3), including mental health counseling."		
SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-316.1(a)(3) reads as rewritten:		
"(3) Providing <u>preventative and responsive services through consultation with</u> students, families, and staff; individual and small group counseling; crisis		
		roup counseling; crisis
counseling; referrals; and peer facilitation." SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
