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SECTION 2. The State Board of Education shall make any necessary revisions to the North Carolina State Plan submitted to the United States Department of Education pursuant to the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act, as amended by the Strengthening Career and Technical Education Act for the 21st Century Act (Pub. L. 115-224), reflecting the requirements of Section 1 of this act for the purposes of complying with federal grant requirements to receive career and technical education federal funds. The State Board shall submit the revisions during the next eligible period for annual revisions on or after the date this act becomes law.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2020-2021 school year.

The Department of Public Instruction shall provide technical assistance to local

school administrative units and work with national accreditation organizations to reduce the

financial burden and time commitment placed on school personnel associated with fulfilling

national accreditation requirements established by the State Board of Education for career and

technical education programs included in a local plan. In addition, the State Board shall only

require an automotive service technology career and technical education program included in a

local plan to be accredited by the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation to the
