A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTENDED TEACHER CONTRACTS. 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-325.3 reads as rewritten: 5 "§ 115C-325.3. Teacher contracts. 6 Length of Contract. – A contract between the local board of education and a teacher (a) 7 who has been employed by the local board of education for less than three years shall be for a 8 term of one school year. A new contract or renewal of contract between the local board of 9 education and a teacher who has been employed by the local board of education as a teacher for 10 three consecutive years or more immediately preceding the effective date of the new or renewed 11 contract shall be for a term of one, two, or four school years. 12 Determination of Consecutive Years of Employment. -(a1) A teacher may be deemed to have been employed for three consecutive years 13 (1)by a local board of education for the purposes of this section if the teacher 14 worked for at least 120 workdays as a teacher in a full-time permanent position 15 in each of the prior three school years. 16 17 If the teacher in a full-time permanent position did not work for at least 120 (2)workdays in a school year because the teacher was on sick leave, disability 18 leave, or on leave taken in accordance with the federal Family and Medical 19 20 Leave Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2601, et seq., for the purposes of this section, that school year shall not (i) be deemed to constitute a consecutive year of 21 employment for the teacher nor (ii) be considered a break in the continuity of 22 23 consecutive years of employment for the teacher. 24" 25 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to contracts executed on or after that date. 26



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
