5 ECONOMIC RESOURCES TO SPECIFICALLY INCLUDE OVERSIGHT OF MARINE  
6 FISHERIES; AND TO ESTABLISH A STATE GOAL OF ONE HUNDRED PERCENT  
7 CLEAN ENERGY BY 2050 AND TO PROMOTE THE CREATION OF GREEN JOBS.";

9 and on page 3, line 51, by rewriting the line to read:

11 "SECTION 6. Article 7 of Chapter 62 of the General Statutes is amended by adding  
12 a new section to read:

13 "**§ 62-133.10A. One hundred percent clean energy goal for North Carolina by 2050.**

14 In order to avoid climate catastrophe, to promote job creation and economic growth, and to  
15 protect the Earth for current and future generations, it shall be the goal of the State that one  
16 hundred percent (100%) of the total retail sales of electricity in North Carolina shall be generated  
17 from renewable energy resources by December 31, 2050. The State Energy Office, in  
18 consultation with the Commission and the Public Staff, shall develop a plan to achieve this goal  
19 and shall submit the plan to the 2020 Regular Session of the 2019 General Assembly upon its  
20 convening."

21 SECTION 7. This act is effective when it becomes law."
