# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT MAKING VARIOUS CHANGES TO THE LABOR LAWS OF NORTH 3 CAROLINA. 4
- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 SECTION 1.1. Article 7A of Chapter 95 of the General Statutes is amended by 6 adding a new section to read: 7

# "§ 95-69.18.1. Investigation reports and records.

- The Commissioner may compile, analyze, and publish, in summary or detailed form, 8 (a) 9 the reports or information obtained under this Article.
- 10 (b)Files and other records relating to investigations and enforcement proceedings pursuant to this Article are not subject to inspection and examination under G.S. 132-6 while the 11 investigations and proceedings are pending, except that a person cited under the provisions of 12 this Article is entitled to receive a copy of the official inspection report, which is the basis for 13 citations received by the person following the issuance of citations." 14

First aid means the one time treatment or 21 22 observation of scratches, cuts not requiring stitches, burns, splinters and contusions or a diagnostic procedure, including examination and x-rays, 23 which does not ordinarily require medical treatment even though provided by 24 25 a physician or other licensed personnel; or
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The occurrence results in damage to the device indicating a substantial defect (2)in design, mechanics, structure or equipment, affecting the future safe operation of the device. No reporting is required in the case of normal wear and tear.
