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on page 57, lines 49-50, by inserting between the lines the following new section to read:

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#### "RESTORE MASTER'S PAY FOR CERTAIN TEACHERS

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**SECTION 7A.1A.(a)** The following session laws are repealed:

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(1) Section 8.22 of S.L. 2013-360.

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Section 8.3 of S.L. 2014-100. (2)

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**SECTION 7A.1A.(b)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, only the following teachers and instructional support personnel shall be paid on the "M" salary schedule or receive a salary supplement for academic preparation at the six-year degree level or at the doctoral degree level for the 2019-2020 school year and subsequent school years:

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Certified school nurses and instructional support personnel in positions for (1) which a master's degree is required for licensure.

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Teachers and instructional support personnel who were paid on that salary (2) schedule or received that salary supplement prior to the 2014-2015 school

22 23 24 (3) Teachers and instructional support personnel who (i) complete a degree at the master's, six-year, or doctoral degree level for which they completed at least one course prior to August 1, 2013, and (ii) would have qualified for the salary supplement pursuant to State Board of Education policy, TCP-A-006, as it was in effect on June 30, 2013.
