moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 5-7, by rewriting those lines to read: "TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL CAREER AND COLLEGE READINESS INFORMATION ON ANNUAL REPORT CARDS, AND TO ALLOW CERTAIN LOTTERY WINNERS TO REMAIN ANONYMOUS FOR NINETY DAYS.";			
and on page 2, lines 45-46, by rewriting those lines to read: "SECTION 5. G.S. 18C-132 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(j1) If requested by the prize winner, the identity of a prize winner of fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) or more shall be treated as confidential information under G.S. 132-1.2(8) until 90 days after the winner has claimed the prize." SECTION 6. G.S. 132-1.2 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(8) Reveals the name, address, or other identifying information of any individual winning more than fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) in a lottery game who requests to remain anonymous for 90 days, as provided in G.S. 18C-132(j1)." SECTION 7. This act is effective when it becomes law. Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 apply to measures based on data from the 2018-2019 school year and each school year thereafter.".
