## 4 "USE OF PREQUALIFIED CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS BY LOCAL 5 GOVERNMENTS

**SECTION 3.2.** G.S. 166A-19.15(f) reads as rewritten:

7 "(f) Additional Powers. – In carrying out the provisions of this Article each political
8 subdivision is authorized to do the following:

- 9 (1) To appropriate and expend funds, make contracts, obtain and distribute 10 equipment, materials, and supplies for emergency management purposes and 11 to provide for the health and safety of persons and property, including 12 emergency assistance, consistent with this Article. 13 (1a) To award contracts for the repair, rehabilitation, or construction of private
- 13 (1a)14 residential structures funded by State or federal funds provided to the political subdivision as a result of a disaster declared by the Governor under 15 G.S. 166A-19.21 covering the political subdivision. For purposes of contracts 16 awarded under this subdivision for a particular disaster, a political subdivision 17 is authorized to contract with contractors prequalified by the Division in 18 accordance with G.S. 143-135.8 for that disaster. In so contracting, the 19 20 political subdivision is not required to follow the procedures for prequalifying contractors set forth in G.S. 143-135.8. Nothing in this subdivision is intended 21 to exempt a political subdivision from other requirements of Article 8 of 22 23 Chapter 143 of the General Statutes. ...."" 24
