## GOVERNOR ROY COOPER OBJECTIONS AND VETO MESSAGE:

House Bill 398, "AN ACT, CONSISTENT WITH HOUSE BILL 966, 2019 REGULAR SESSION, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS."

This legislation fails to adequately fund state cybersecurity and data analytics needs while sending a substantial capital earmark outside the state's proven university system.

Therefore, I veto the bill.
